

GCARC NET SCRIPT

(PREAMBLE) Good evening, This is (**CALL SIGN**). My name is (**YOUR NAME**) and I am net control for the GREATER COLLEGEDALE ADVENTIST RADIO NET. This net meets every Thursday evening at approximately 1900 hours local time on the White Oak Mt. Repeater, 147.000 mhz positive offset with PL Tone 131.8 hz.

This net is affiliated with the GREATER COLLEGEDALE ADVENTIST RADIO CLUB also known as GCARC, and its purpose is to fellowship, to exchange information and experience so we can better help our community, and to practice our operating skills. For more info about GCARC, and to join the club, visit our website at www.collegedalehams.org.

This is a directed net. All stations are asked to remain on frequency unless excused or the net secures. Stations will be called for by the first letter of your callsign suffix. Please use proper ITU phonetics when checking in. The net is divided into 2 parts: We will start with check-ins and announcements, and then transition to round-table and general discussion. Everyone is invited to participate.

Do we have any emergency traffic; If so, please reply with your call..... Nothing heard.

NET CONTROL INSTRUCTION: If emergency traffic has been received, call for any stations on frequency that can handle the listed traffic. Record stations handling the traffic and the number of messages being exchanged between each station or stations.

(CHECK-INS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS) Are there any stations wishing to check into the GCARC net with suffix beginning: (**LOG check-ins**)

[A]lpha through [M]ike?

[N]ovember through [Z]ulu?

Are there any late or missed stations on frequency that desire to check-in to the GCARC net?

Are there any bulletins, announcements, comments, or questions for the net? If so, please give your call. (TAKE CALLS and direct in order received) (Typically the club president or other assigned person will have prepared a list of announcements to make at this time)

(ROUND-TABLE) This completes the first portion of our net. We will now have a round-table discussion, the main topic this evening is _____, but feel free to deviate if you have a topic to discuss. (Check periodically for additional check-ins and allow breaks for emergency traffic.)

(CLOSING) At this time we will bring the GREATER COLLEGEDALE ADVENTIST RADIO NET to a close. This net will meet again next Thursday evening at 1900 hours on this frequency.

Remember to visit our website and sign-up for net control, we would like everyone to be proficient in handling the net. We have a number of slots available.

I thank everyone for checking in this evening, and the amateur community for allowing us a clear operating frequency. We will now return this frequency back to normal amateur use, (**CALL SIGN**) is now clear. 73's and good night.
